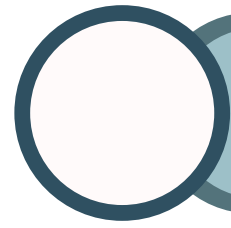

Some Spelling rules:



Some words have letters that are ***written*** but not pronounced

. A combination of two letters, one of them is silent:

1) Words begin with (wr) the w is silent

Example:

wrong - write - wrap

2) Words begin with (kn) the k is silent:

Example:

knife - know -knee- knowledge

3) Words that ends with (mn) the n is silent

Example: autumn



words that always have a Silent T in English:



1) If the word ends in (**sten**) we don't pronounce/read the (t)

Example:

listen - **fasten**

2- (**stle**) t is also silent

Example:

whistle - **castle**

3-words that have a Silent H :

1) **Wh-** at the beginning of the word

Example:

where - **when** - **why** **which** - **while** - **white** - **whether**

2) Rh:

Example: Rhino

3-gh:

Example: right - high - tonight

No rule for these words but the H is silent < honest - hour- honor

Reading words that ends in Suffixes -tion, -ssion sion, - cian :

They are all pronounced as (**shun**)



Example:

information

ssion

Commission

-cian

Spelling rule: it is usually written for words ending in (c)

It is used for people jobs

Ex: music > musician

politics > politician

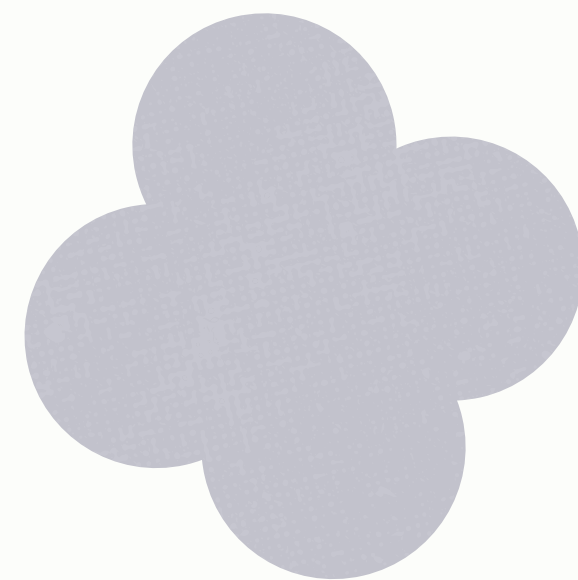
